ChecksQuick™ 3.2 What's New

- Check amounts of up to 99,999.99 can now be used.
- A new dropdown button on each Payment Card allows users to quickly jump to a specific card.

New Check Layout Option:

- Landscape feeding of checks is now supported on left and right-feeding printers through the addition of a **y-Offset** adjustment. Previously, landscape feeding was only supported on center-feeding printers.

ChecksQuick™ 3.1 What's New

New Preferences:

- You may now use your System date (set in the Date control panel) as the default date format.
- When using a Custom Date, you may enter anything (e.g., Stardate 2574.4). If you do not use a legitimate date format, you will receive a warning. However, you will be allowed to use the date if you wish.
- You may now choose between the former ChecksQuick "natural" language amount in words (Two hundred & one 00/100) or the "official" amount in words (Two hundred one & 00/100).

New Check Layout Option:

A user having an HP LaserJet(R) 1012 (a center-feeding printer) found that the printing was consistently about 3 inches too far to the left (or was it the right?). In any event, I added a **x-Offset** field to allow for large movements of the printing in either direction (use negative numbers for moving to the left). This optional field shows up when the Center Feeding & Landscape? button is checked, and the value you enter (in points - 72 points/inch; approx. 28 points/cm) is saved with your Check Layout.
