Introduction



The software is completely crossed platform which means that you can create and take the test on any operating system that has Java installed.

Main Window *(continued)*

The main window is where the teacher will spend most of their time. From this window you create the test.

To create a test you simply need to add the question, provide the answer and points to give that particular question. When you are finished with that question, press the “Save Question” button. You can navigate through your questions by pressing the “Previous” and “Next” buttons. When you are finished creating the test, press the “Finished” button.

You can always save your progress by pressing the “Save” button at the top of the screen.


In Test-2-U, there are four types of question you can choose from. They are; (4 option) Multiple Choice, True False, Fill in the Blank, and Short Answer (essay). Except for the Short Answer type question, Test-2-U will grade all the questions for you. Short Answer questions will have to be graded after the test is complete.

*******ATTENTION*******

Fill in the Blank questions will only grant points to answers that spelled exactly as you specify in the test making process.

The Finish Window provides the test creator to further customize the test. From this window you can specify the Test name, class, teacher and description for the test. Also you may specify any email and password information.

If you choice to password protect your test, you will need to provide your password every time you open the test in Test-2-U (Professor).

The test can also specify if the test is printable and or having the ability to pause. If you wish to allow pausing of the test you may also require a password to pause the test will testing is going on. You would do this by selecting "Require Password to Pause test" check box in the Finish Window.

Finish Window *(continued)*

The Finish window also will allow you to make the test timed and if the Test-2-U should be the only visible window while testing is going on.

To make the test timed select “Timed Test”. Next you will need to specify how long in minutes the test will be. You do this by clicking on the “Select Time Limit” combo box, scroll down to your desired length.

To make the test Full screen means that Test-2-U will always be on top of all other visible windows. This is good if you do not want the testee to use other resources than what you have supplied them.

Other Information

Licensing

When officially download you will be provided with a license file and a full version of the software. The Test-2-U (Student Edition) can be installed on all the student you have. When a student is no longer your student...YOU MUST REMOVE THE SOFTWARE FROM THEIR MACHINE. You may not distribute the software to anyone else than your students.

The Test-2-U (Teacher) software is to be installed on only your machine and or any support staff you may have in your classroom. No one else may obtain the software through you. The Test-2-U (Student) license is free with registration. The Test-2-U(Teacher) is purchased per-license.

Other Information

Email

For the most part the email function will work everywhere. However some schools/network administrators may block certain ports. If the email doesn't work ask them if port 587 is blocked if it is you will have to ask them if they can unblock that port.
